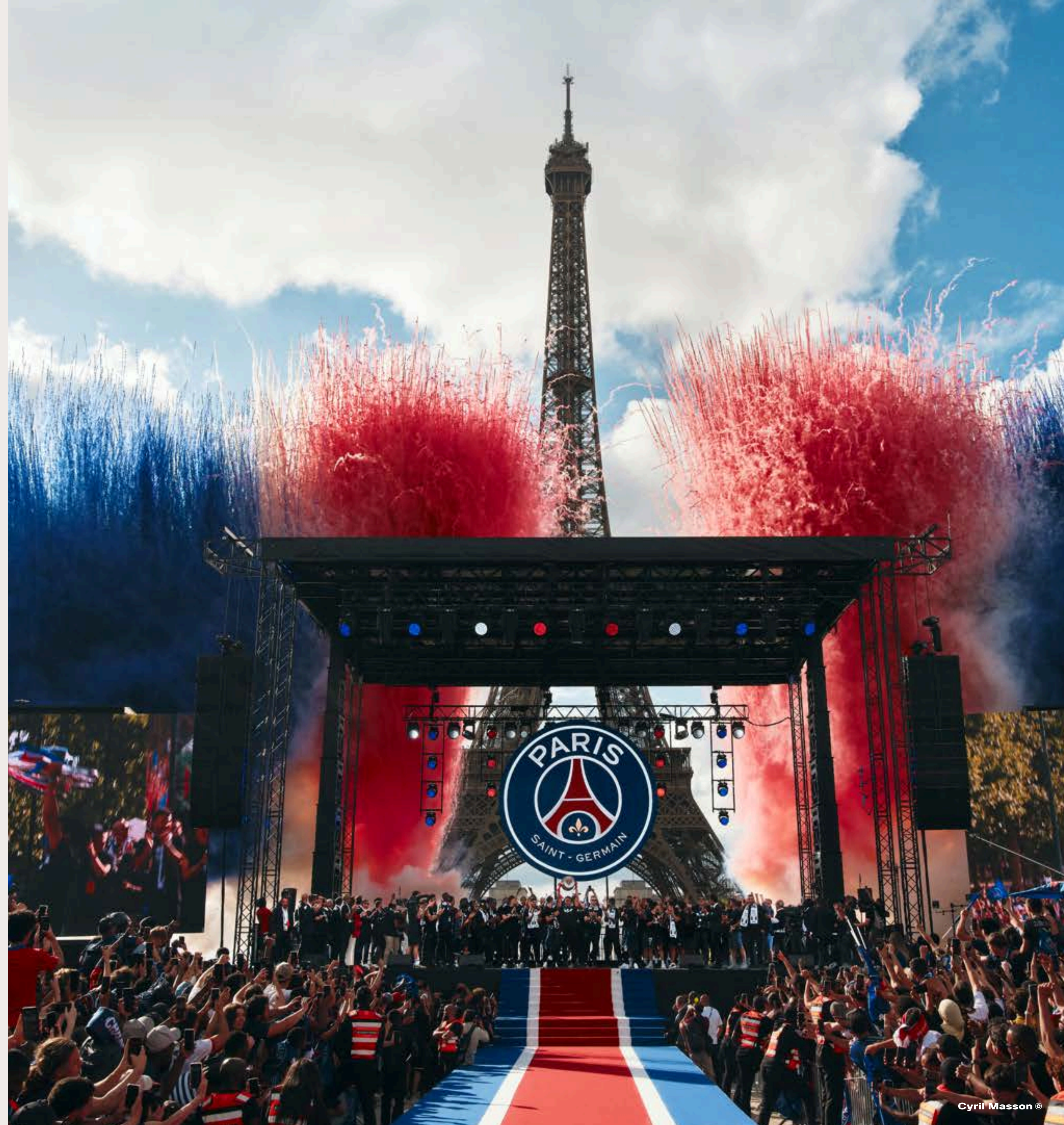

Paris Saint-Germain Judo continues to pursue an ambitious development strategy aimed at nurturing the champions of tomorrow - with the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games firmly in its sights - while making the practice of judo accessible to as many people as possible.

This season, the Club further strengthened its position on the international stage by winning the Judo Champions League for the second consecutive year and securing numerous medals across the senior, junior and cadet categories, reflecting its long-standing commitment to youth development and the transmission of excellence.

The Club has also demonstrated its ability to attract world-class talent, highlighted by the arrival at the start of the season of Joan-Benjamin Gaba, Olympic silver medallist in the individual event and Olympic champion in the team event at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, as well as 2025 World Champion.

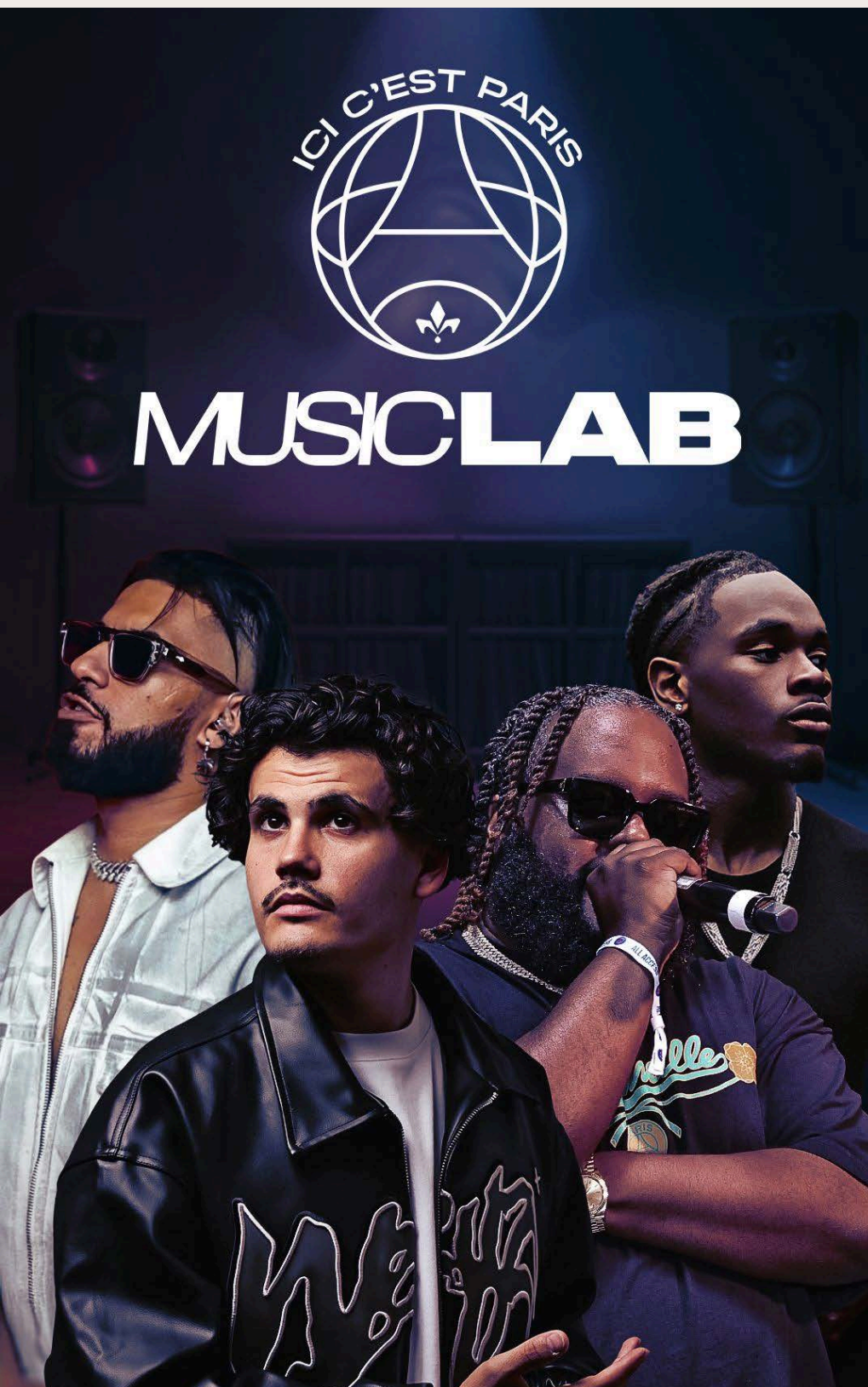

SHOWCASING THE CREATIVE TALENT OF THE NEW GENERATION

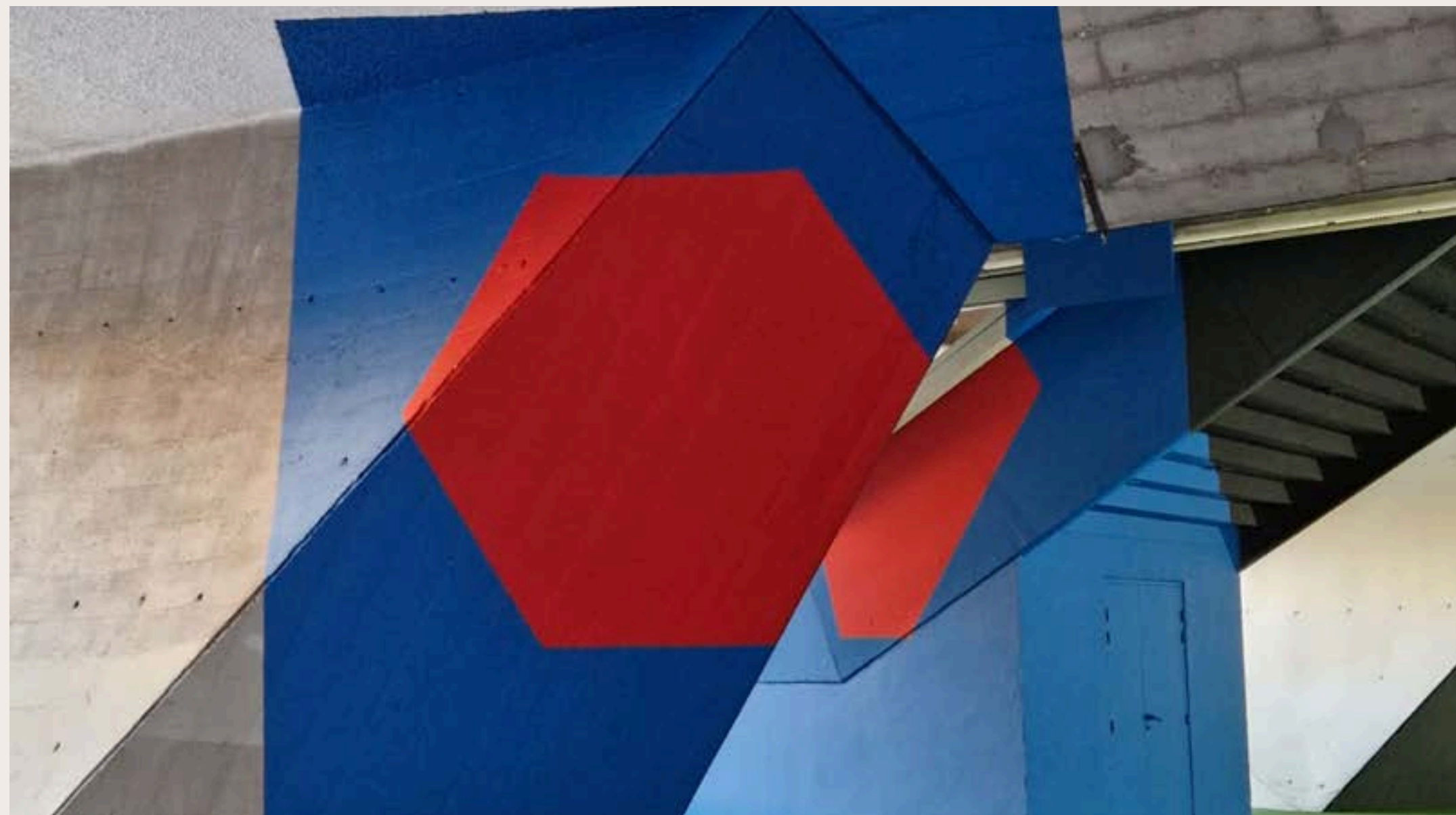

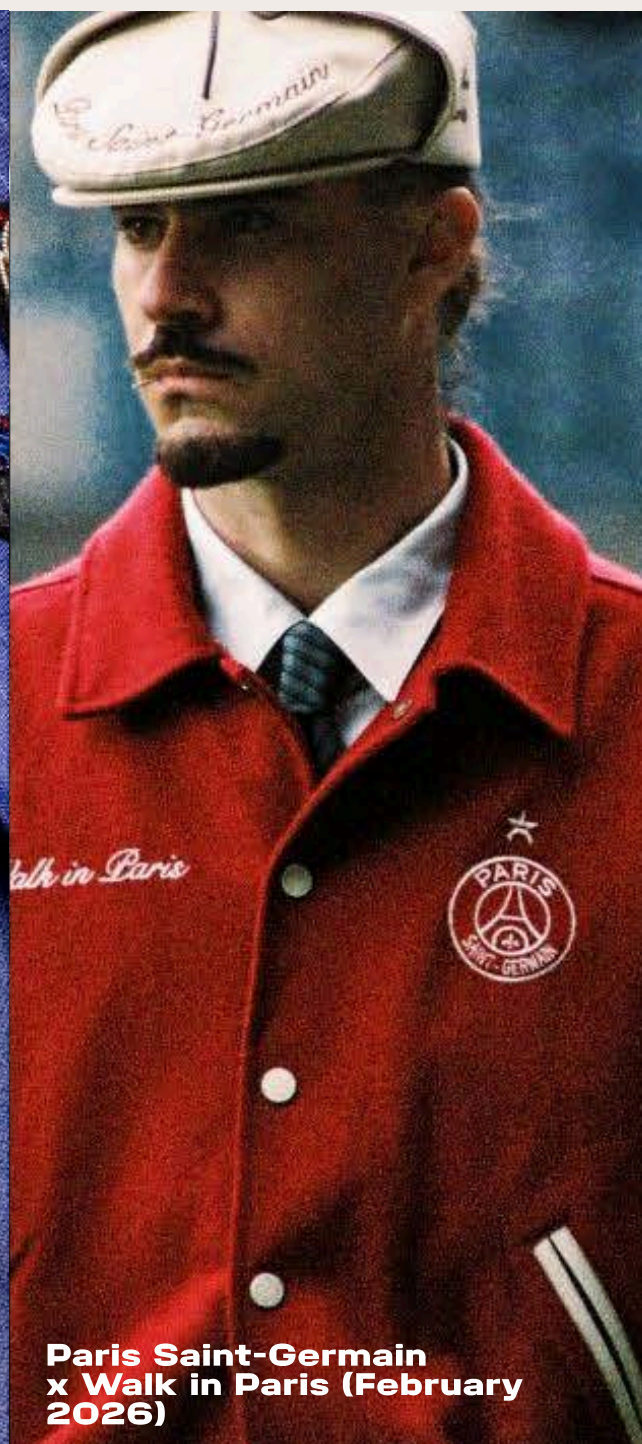

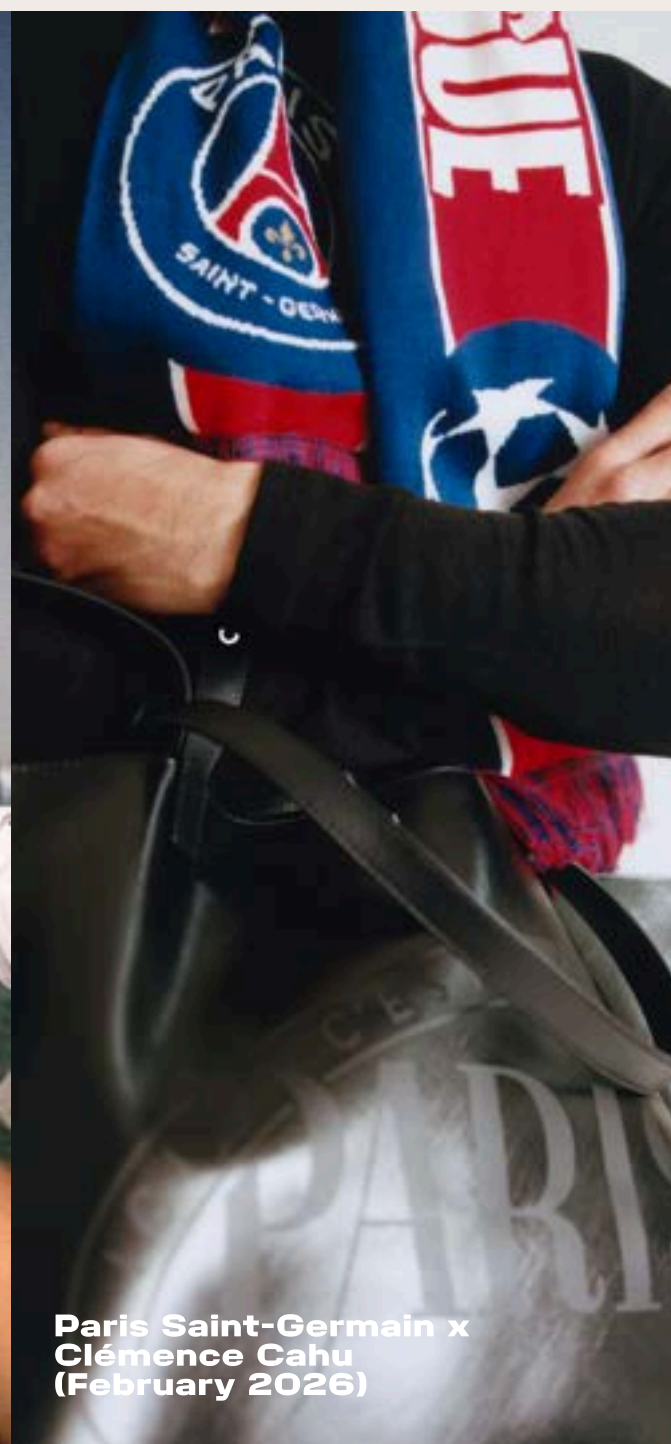
